



## **MOTA-ENGIL ANNOUNCES THE SIGNING OF A CONCESSION AGREEMENT IN THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO**

MOTA-ENGIL S.G.P.S., S.A. (MOTA-ENGIL) hereby announces that its subsidiary MOTA-ENGIL AFRICA sign today a concession agreement for the operation, management, modernization, rehabilitation and maintenance of the Lobito Corridor, specifically the section between Dilolo to Sakania (approximately 1,037 km) in the Democratic Republic of the Congo ("DRC"). This concession will provide a strategic rail connection between the Zambian border (Sakania) and the Angolan border (Dilolo), thereby ensuring railway access from the mining areas of Lualaba and Haut-Katanga in the DRC to the Port of Lobito in Angola and, consequently, to international markets.

Under the terms of the agreement, MOTA-ENGIL AFRICA will be responsible, for a period of 30 years, for the operation, management and maintenance of the railway infrastructure dedicated to the transportation of goods, minerals, liquids and gases along the corridor integrated into the Lobito Corridor Railway Concession (in Angola) now extended from the Port of Lobito to Sakania, in the Haut-Katanga Province of southern DRC. Total investment over the concession period is expected to amount to approximately USD 1.8 billion.

With this award, the GROUP continues to strengthen its backlog and diversify its project portfolio, thereby supporting sustainable revenue generation and long-term growth.
